R&G recognises the upmost importance of ensuring that we adhere to our values of delivering the finest quality fresh cut herbs and ingredients to our customers, without compromising the environment we work. Thus, senior management team are committed to delivering our aspiration of Zero landfill target.

R&G recognises and accepts that concern for the environment is an integral part of its business strategy and operating methods. The impact on the environment made by us is constantly monitored. We also take all steps to minimise consumption and waste by ensuring we only buy what we need and re-use wherever possible. Steps taken such as added value raw material, herbs that are bunched abroad and do not require trimming (hence creating waste) have helped reduce green considerably.

At R&G we are always looking for ways to improve our environmental performance that can be implemented without compromising our business objectives. Use of greywater harvesting and heat recovery system is undertaken.

With continued focus on our carbon footprint and protecting our planet, R&G (who already consume power that is from sustainable energy sources, renewable energy) have signed up for the solar panelling with oak-apple renewable energy to be in place within 6 months.

All staff are encouraged to be mindful of electrical use and to switch all machines and lights off before leaving for the day. We recycle paper and toner cartridges, as well as batteries.

R&G encourages suppliers to implement policies that protect the environment by working to LEAF environmental schemes or similar on farms globally.
